## SCOPE

The Framework Agreeemnt is only available for use by five participating members in the North-East, and their subsidiaries. These are Durham, Newcastle, Northumbria, Sunderland and Teeside Universities.

The works will involve all aspects of minor building works (refurbishment and improvement schemes) typical of University buildings such as but not limited to Laboratories, small and complex Lecture Theatres, Libraries, café and commercial kitchens, offices (individual and open plan), public areas, meeting rooms, conference rooms, student accommodation, plant areas, etc.

The value of each scheme shall be between £1m and £4.1m

Whilst the call-offs from this framework will be predominantly for refurbishment and improvement schemes, there may be the occasional new construction scheme as well.

The nature of the works will mean that most schemes are delivered in live buildings.
