SCOPE

The purpose of this framework agreement is to deliver an efficient and compliant route to market for participating public bodies, by minimising the resource and providing value for money. This framework agreement was procured via the open procedure tendering process and advertised on Intend and in the Official Journal of the European Union (OJEU) 2015/S 058-102189.

AGREEMENT BENEFITS

Institutions have the assurance that this framework of suppliers has passed every through examination at the tender stage, and that the specification criteria and questions have been set by courier and parcel specialists and procurement managers from across the UK HE consortia membership. The tender award has achieved many of the tender aspirations set out in the strategy document. The Commodity Strategy Group identified that profit margins within this sector are relatively small (typically <5%) thus it is reported that cash savings of 3% can be anticipated.
